

Prescribing Medicines from iCaSH Services

iCaSH services are only able to prescribe a limited number of medicines associated with the specialist services that we provide.

These include contraceptive medicines and those used to improve sexual health and treat sexually transmitted infections. The aim of this is to ensure the safety and quality of prescribing and to avoid patient harm.

We are therefore unable to prescribe medicines for the management of any other health conditions, such as asthma, diabetes, depression or high blood pressure. Should you need a prescription for these, you will need to see your GP. This is because your GP is better placed to manage these conditions and they will be responsible for your monitoring and follow-up. They will also be able to signpost you to other relevant services and/or refer your care onto other specialists should this be required.
